NEW CORPORATE REQUIREMENTS FOR CONTINUED DEFENCE SUPPORT

The Department of Defence has put out new and revised guidelines for a continuation of the Grant-in-Aid (GIA) paid annually to all constituent bodies of the RUSI of Australia.

To justify the payment to Tasmania (\$2000 per annum) we have to provide comprehensive reports on all our activities and financial operations particularly the manner in which we spend GIA monies.

All our monthly presentations must be listed and quantified and we have to demonstrate that all our activities are in line with the stated aim, that of promoting debate and the dissemination of information on Defence and Security related issues. We also are required to give a budget projection for the forthcoming year and how we intend to charge expenditure against the monies granted to us.

It is important to remember that we must continually align our activities to coincide with the aims of the RUSI of Australia and therefore our monthly presentations must be focussed in that direction.

We are hopeful that our submission, along with those of all the other State RUSIs, will be such as to convince Defence that we are in the military community and the public arena promoting Defence and Security as they affect this country.

Members will be kept apprised of the results of our submission.
